## Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, in said County, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Etna, County of Penobscot, Maine qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Etna Community Hall in said Town on Thursday the 17th day of July, 2025, at 7:00 pm in the evening, then and there to act upon the following articles to wit:

- **Article 1:** To choose a moderator, to preside at said meeting.
- **Article 2:** To see if the Town of Etna will authorize to change the status of the Etna Volunteer Fire Department to the Etna Municipal Fire Department.
- **Article 3:** To see if the Town of Etna will raise and appropriate the sum of \$20,842 to Northern Light Transport Ambulance to provide a transporting ambulance for the town. \*Note: The charge is \$17 per person, based on 2020 census data showing a population of 1,226 residents.
- **Article 4:** To see if the Town of Etna will raise and appropriate the sum of \$10,000 to a reserve account for the purpose of regionalization for fire and EMS with area departments. If towns are in agreement in the future to regionalize, then these funds would be used for the purpose of getting the entity started.
